




A-View<sup>®</sup> is inserted into the trachea of fully anaesthetized patients. The balloon catheter is filled with saline to enable echo conduction through the trachea, thus resolving the blind spot of TEE. The following views can be obtained with A-View<sup>®</sup> enhanced TEE.




Upper Esophagus Distal Ascending Aorta, Long-Axis







Upper Esophagus Aortic Arch Branch Vessels, Short-Axis




## A-View<sup>®</sup> Enhanced TEE with endotracheal balloon catheter




Upper Esophagus Innominate Artery, Long-Axis
